# North Main Gravity Sewer Improvement Project

Beginning Monday, January 20, 2025, Tiffany Construction CO will begin installing the new gravity sewer improvements to replace the existing gravity sewer behind Pizzeria Bocce. The sewer improvement will go through the Yuma Street Corridor, continuing through the Main Street and Cactus Street intersections and up to Kindra Heights Road. During construction, there will be temporary traffic lanes or road closures on North Main Street and Cactus Street, as well as Yuma Street and Kindra Heights Road, to complete the new sewer improvements.

Tiffany Construction will maintain and move traffic control devices as required for the new sewer improvements and open the respective road when that segment of the sewer is completed.
